The People & Culture function was established in October 2019 and has experienced 100% turnover in the team during the period October 2019 to March 2021. This means the

P&C team has not been able to progress the activities indicated in the timeframes notated in the 2019-2020 submission. A new team is now in place with a focus to develop the systems, processes, policies, and procedures required to support the business and its commitment to gender equality.
